They are committed to the idea of facilitating a Mock Car Crash. Both Hurley High School and Northland Pines High School held mock crashes this past week with much success, and a very high impact on their audiences. While Mock Crashes are not considered evidence-based programs, the group discussed ways to being those evidence-based ideas into the process:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Host a series of school assemblies over the course of the next school year (high school and elementary)-each with a different topic on underage drinking <ol style="list-style-type: none"> a. Alcohol and the developing teenage brain b. Insurance, legal risks and other consequences for Parents Who Host underage drinking c. Emergency room issues and perspectives d. Judicial and legal perspectives e. Local policies-Placement of alcohol in stores/advertising 2. Enlist local coalitions to help with aspects of the project <ol style="list-style-type: none"> a. Providing data and statistics on underage drinking that students could use to raise awareness e.g. school TV during lunchtime b. Help with contacting officials about the Mock Crash c. Help with finding presenters for assemblies on underage drinking 3.
